### The 10/40 Window

The 10/40 Window is the rectangular area of North Africa, the Middle East and Asia approximately between 10 degrees north and 40 degrees north latitude.

Over 3 billion people living in these countries are considered unreached.

Many of the largest unreached people groups live here, which includes the majority of the world's Muslims, Hindus, and Buddhists.

Repeat after me:


Dear God,


