Who Are Frontier People Groups?

Frontier People Groups are people grouped by language and culture. They are "Frontier" because fewer than 0.1% are Christian. That means fewer than one person in 1,000 identifies with Jesus in any way!

There are about 5,000 Frontier People Groups. This prayer guide shows 31 of the largest groups. Your prayers will cover a total of 700 million people! Many are Muslims or Hindus. Statistically, they won't ever meet a Christian in their lifetime.

With so few Christians, Frontier People Groups need missionaries. Pray for Christians to go and help them become followers of Jesus!

We invite you and your family to pray for 31 Frontier People Groups.

SUPERFICIALLY REACHED


Few evangelicals, but many who identify as Christians. In great need of spiritual renewal and commitment to biblical faith.

I hope that my friends who are coming over later will enjoy these two dishes as well!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Ask God to restore political peace and stability to Afghanistan.
- Ask God to call Christian workers trained in the Dari language to take the gospel to the Tajiks and plant strong local churches.
- Pray that relief funds will be available for those living in famine-stricken areas.



Algerian Tuareg

i ('ahlan)! Hi there! My name is Amastan, and I'm nine years old and I belong to the Tuareg people in Algeria. My father and I are traveling to the nearby well with our donkey to bring back some water for our family. What I'm most excited about is playing a game called melghas with my friends! Melghas is a game where kids first hide themselves. Then, another tries to find and tag them before they reach the well for a drink. The last time we played, I got caught before even touching the well. This time, I'll outrun all the other kids and reach the well first!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Algeria is not very welcoming to Christian workers. Pray for missionaries to be creative in sharing the gospel with the Tuareg and Algerian people.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to soften the hearts of Muslim tribes. Pray that they will receive the gospel.
- Pray for the few Tuareg believers to reflect Christ and the gospel in their communities.

PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray that the Hui people will have a hunger for spiritual truth that will lead them to seek and find Christ with their Christian neighbors.
- Pray for the Chinese believers to do whatever it takes to introduce Jesus Christ to the Muslim Hui people.
- Pray for a disciple-making movement to flourish among the Hui people.

Kazakh

Our people are known for being horsemen and nomads, meaning that we travel from place to place in search of fresh pasture for our livestock. For generations, my family and I have cared for dozens of horses in the grasslands. This horse's name is Inju, she's very special to me because she's been with me since birth. She never leaves my side, and helps me take care of newborn horses and foals. Sometimes, I ride her while letting the other horses roam free. Inju and I are forever friends, and she will always hold a special place in my heart!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Ask the Lord to send long-term laborers to live among Kazakhs and share the love of Christ with them.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to open the hearts of the Kazakhs towards Christians so that they will be receptive to the gospel.
- Ask the Lord to raise up strong local churches among Kazakhs.





Mongol

Сайн байна yy (san ban oh)! I'm Batu and I am nine-years-old. I have my bow and arrow ready for this year's Naadam Festival. This is a festival Mongolians celebrate in the summer. It has three main events: wrestling, horse racing, and archery. These are also called the "three games of men." This year, my friends and I are competing in archery as a team. Even though I am a boy, I will do my best to hit as many targets as I can!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- There are an unconfirmed number of Christian Mongols. Pray for these believers to share the gospel with non-believers, to stand firm in their faith, and trust in God.
- Pray for God to help the Mongolians through harsh winters. Pray that Mongolians can experience spiritual warmth from God's love and grace.
- Many Mongols worship forces of nature (such as the moon, stars, sun, and rivers). Pray that God can reveal Himself to the Mongols as the one true God.



PRAYER ITEMS:


- Pray that Han Chinese believers can lead the way and show the compassion of Christ to the Uyghurs.
- Today, over one million Uyghurs are being detained and placed in internment camps. Pray for protection over the Uyghur men, women, and children in these camps.
- Pray for Uyghurs to find Jesus in their pain and that God would use this very suffering to lead them to the kingdom.





Ansari

ا بيلو! (halloo) I'm Nasirah, an Ansari woman living in Uttar Pradesh, India. I'm a seamstress, and I work in the large textile industry within my community. It's the same job that my mother and grandmother did before me. Every day, I work on my hand-loom to make silk dresses, like the one I'm wearing right now! Today, I'm going down to the rural villages with my family to provide help for the less fortunate farmers. I have a tight-knit family and we love to help out in our community whenever we can!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray that God would send Indian followers of Jesus to their Ansari neighbors to share with them the good news.
- Pray for a disciple-making movement among them this decade.
 - Pray for good schools so that Ansari children can get an education that helps to lift them out of poverty.

नमस्ते (namaste)! My name is Eshana, and I am a Baniyan spice merchant in India. All of my spices are homemade by my family and I. Do you want some herbs to make your tea sweet or some spice to make your soup spicy? We have it all! I sell my spices to local villagers and neighbors. Sometimes, I like to trade spices with neighboring villages and merchants too. The ingredients that are local there are different from the ones we find at home. You never know what kind of spices you'll find!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray for the salvation of these people and that God may send several Christian workers among them and meet their spiritual and physical needs.
- Pray for developmental and literacy programs.
- Pray for a spiritual hunger in the Baniyan and Vanian community that will lead them to Christ.





Brahmin

शुभ प्रभात (shubh prabhaat). Good morning, I am Ved. Would you like to observe me performing this worship ritual? Only the Brahmin are able to perform this special ritual, as we are the only caste that can be priests. It is a great honor for outsiders to observe, because we only perform our Hindu rituals for those in higher castes. The younger generation of Brahmin no longer seek this ancient practice, and few know the knowledge of Vedas. Most are now seeking to be educators, lawmakers, scholars, doctors, politicians, computer engineers, and so on. However, as an elder priest, I hope to spread the importance of our tradition and knowledge.



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Brahmins are seen as knowledgeable and enlightened; pray for the light of the gospel to bring the knowledge of Christ to them in India.
- Pray for wisdom for disciples of Jesus who befriend and share their faith with Brahmins.
- Pray that the true God will reveal Himself to this community and use Brahmins to preach and teach about Jesus Christ.



My mother would catch me, then teach me to dry and iron the clothes that my father had washed. Now that I'm older, I try to help my parents earn money in every way I can. Lately, there have been fewer customers due to the popularity of washing machines. I hope that I can support my parents for as long as I can.



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Since many of their professions are going out of business, pray for the Dhobi people to gain access to better education and new skills in the modern world.
- Pray that the Dhobi people will hear the gospel and that only Jesus Christ can wash away their sins.
- Pray that the Holy Spirit will give the Dhobi people spiritual hunger that they will not be satisfied until they taste and see that the Lord is good.





Jat

ਸਤ ਸਰੀ ਅਕਾਲ, (sata srī akāla), I'm Jumari! I'm a Jat woman from Punjab. Right now, I'm working on this phulkari, or embroidery. My favorite part is these little flowers, don't they look nice? I learned how to embroider from my mother, and I'm making this one for my sister's wedding this year. The wedding will have a total of 100 of these pieces of embroidery! I had my own wedding last year, which is why I wear this nathli, or nose ring. All the married women in my community wear rings like this, and some even have decorative beads on them. Alright, enough talking, I have to get back to work!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray that Christian doctors, nurses, and humanitarian aid workers will have opportunities to share the love of Jesus.
- Ask the Lord to bring forth growing churches among the Jats for the glory of His name.
- Pray that churches and missions organizations will accept the challenge of adopting and reaching the Jats.

I am on my way to the farm while walking Annya to school. She will be entering high school this year! She has to carry a lot of books with her, so I hope she didn't forget anything!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Ask the Lord to send Indian believers to the Kapu to tell them about Jesus Christ.
- Kapu live in villages that often lack access to modern medicine, electricity, and clean water.
 Pray that the spiritual and physical needs of the Kapu are met by Jesus Christ.
- Hinduism is widely practiced among the Kapu people. Pray that God will open the minds and hearts of the Kapu to the truth of the Bible and reveal Himself as the one true God.



First, I let the fresh clay dry. Then, I add a thin base color, and once that dries, I get to add circles, lines, and swirls as decoration! This bowl's going to be part of a matching set I created!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray for a spiritual hunger in the Kumhar community that will lead them to Christ.
- Pray for a disciple-making movement that will bless the Kumhar this decade.
- Pray for the Lord to send out teams of workers to help the Kumhar people with their spiritual and physical needs.

Kunbi

नमस्ते (namaste), I'm Advik! I'm a Kunbi man from Gujarat. Right now, my village is preparing for our tradition of the Goa Dance! In a few moments, the women will start dancing while all the men will play these ghumots, or drums. We perform this dance as a prayer for protection over our homes and community. We're also dressed in traditional clothing for this dance, and both the men and women wear a pink color. The pink dye comes from the manjistha plant, which we use in a lot of our clothing. Oh, they're calling me now, see you later!



PRAYER ITEMS:


- Pray for the salvation of the Kunbi people and that God may send Christian workers to work among them and meet their spiritual and physical needs.
- Pray for the Kunbi Christians to reach out to their own people.
- Pray that their men and women may give up smoking.





Mahratta

नमस्ते (namaste)! My name is Grishma and I am a Mahratta woman from India. I work at home by doing different chores around the house while my husband takes care of our cows. He uses livestock to help till the soil and harvest crops. Earlier, I washed our clothes by hand. This means rubbing soap on the clothes against a piece of concrete, then rinsing them in a bucket of water. Right now, I am cooking porridge over an open fire so that my husband can eat when he comes home. I can't wait for this busy day to be over!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray that the Mahratta people can find hope and receive the free gift of the gospel.
- Pray for God to turn the Mahratta people away from worshiping false idols.
- Mahrattas are part of the upper rural class; the majority of families own land and raise farm crops. As a result, they look down upon people they consider as not their equal. Pray that Mahrattas can experience God's love and grace.



My job includes giving haircuts, shaving beards, and occasional wedding preparations. Giving haircuts may not seem like much, but it is meaningful because I get to give people a new appearance. When I see smiles on people's faces, I feel happy and proud of my work. I hope this boy will like his new haircut!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray for Indian believers to build friendships with the Nai and tell them about the Savior.
- Pray for a disciple-making movement that will bless the Nai people this decade.
- Many Nai do not know how to read. Pray for access to biblical audio materials and for God to lead the Nai to listen to Christian radio programs in their languages.



Rajput

नमस्ते (namaste), I am Mahendra. I'm a Rajput man from Uttar Pradesh. We Rajputs descended from royal lineage, and we continue these traditions of honor today. This is a ceremonial sword that's used in weddings and other ceremonies, and this is the traditional clothing for the annual Camel Festival. Another important tradition for my community is how we style our beards! As you can see, I curl up my mustache and beard, just like many of the men in my community. This is just one of the many ways we preserve and express our culture!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray for the Rajput community to increase awareness of Jesus and their need for Him.
- Pray that the Lord will give Rajputs a spiritual hunger and satisfy that hunger.
- Pray that Rajputs will understand the value of becoming a part of God's royal family.

Right now we're saving up money for a mechanical oil press, which will make work much easier.




PRAYER ITEMS:

Yadav

नमस्ते (namaste)! My name is Daivi and this is my big brother Dhiman. He is my best friend and it's never boring when we work together! We have to take care of the cattle from early morning to night, but sometimes it is fun! During breaks, we like to wrestle with our cousins and sing and dance a lot, too. We also like listening to the stories our aunties and uncles tell us about the gods like Vishnu and Krishna. They even taught us how to pray regularly to Singaji to protect our cattle and present offerings like butter, unripe mangoes, and sugar. Life is not too bad, but sometimes I wish I could go to school like other children instead of working in the fields.



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray for the salvation of the Yadav people and for missionaries to pioneer new ministries among them.
- Pray for literacy and community development work.
- Pray for the practice of child labor to end and for education to be made available to all children, especially girls.

They've grown so tall in such a short period of time! Our people are very big on agriculture in the countryside, where there are thousands of plants to explore and harvest. Because of Malaysia's humid weather, we're able to grow all kinds of fruits and vegetables. Some of my favorites are durian, jambu merah, mangosteen, and rambutan!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Ask the Lord of the harvest to send forth laborers to work among each Malay group.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to grant wisdom and favor to missions agencies focusing on the Malay.
- Pray that God will give the small number of Malay believers boldness to share Christ with their own people.





Moroccan

(salam), I'm Ilias. I'm from Morocco, and right now I'm on my family's farm. I work here with my parents and sister, and I'm in charge of milking the goats every morning! I also watch over the chickens and sheep. I love taking care of them! I'm wearing a hat called a fez and many of the boys from Morocco wear them. Usually, I'm not dressed this fancy, but this robe is special for holidays.



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Ask the Holy Spirit to soften the hearts of Moroccan Arabs toward Christians so that they will be receptive to the gospel.
- Pray that God will call forth teams of intercessors who will faithfully stand in the gap for Moroccan Arabs.
- Ask God to give Moroccan Arab believers boldness to share the love of Christ with their friends and families.

Rakhine

A long-running tradition of our people is taking the sprigs of thabyay plants (leaves of tropical plants) and using them to sprinkle scented water on our friends and family from silver bowls. Another custom we enjoy is the endless stalls of Burmese street foods, where everything is free during the festival. It's a celebration of life and rebirth!



PRAYER ITEMS:


- Pray that the Rakhine people will be able to adequately use the Burmese Bible for written literature.
- Pray that evangelistic materials (such as audio-visual materials, songs, tracts, etc.) in the Rakhine language will be produced.
- Pray for a spiritual hunger in the Rakhine community that will lead them to Christ.





Fulani

Sannu! My name is Maimuna (left), and this is my mother, Nabilah (right). We belong to the Fulani people in Nigeria. The two of us just got back from a short journey, where we delivered milk to our tribe's children. When we travel, my mother and I wear these face markings and carry these special milk bowls to represent which tribe we are from. Our tribe is scattered over many pastures because we are semi-nomadic, meaning that we travel great distances to find supplies and shelter, while also taking care of cattle and other animals. I can't wait to see where we go next!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray that the few Christian believers among the Fulani people would be sent teachers to help them become well established in their faith.
- Pray they would find each other in order to fellowship together, and that they would learn to live in the power of Christ's Spirit, experiencing His fruit consistently.
- Pray that the Fulani will be able to care adequately for their families and that they will be better prepared for the rapidly changing conditions of the 21st century.

PRAYER ITEMS:


- Pray that the Almighty God will lead faithful workers to take the message of salvation to the Arain people in Pakistan.

Pashtun

(salaam alaikum)! I'm Mahzala, a Pashtun woman from Pakistan. I am wearing this bright and colorful dress because I am practicing for the Attan dance. This is a folk dance that Pashtuns performed in times of war or weddings, and it is now the national dance. The dancers, men and women, move in a circle while clapping and turning along to the rhythm of drums. I am so excited to perform this dance, and I hope everyone will enjoy it too!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- The greatest barriers to faith are social and cultural barriers. Pashtuns in Pakistan have been called the largest Muslim tribal society in the world. Pray for Pashtuns to find true hope and salvation through Jesus Christ.
- No one knows how many Pashtuns are following Jesus. Seeds of the gospel have been sown widely. Pray for the Holy Spirit to strengthen and protect new believers against any persecution so their lives can be a witness for God.
- Pray for the Bible translations in progress.

Wolof

Salaam aleekum, I'm Fadia! I'm a Wolof woman living in Senegal, Africa. Right now, I'm in the village square. All of the community events take place here, such as dancing and wrestling matches! In my community, one of the most important things for both women and men is how we dress, and I love to wear fancy dresses and headdresses. Later, I'll be going to the market to buy grain for my family. Many of the people at the market will be dressed in formal clothing because clothing is such an important part of our culture!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray for the small number of Wolof believers to have the courage to share the love of Christ with their own people and be strong through persecution.
- Ask the Lord to give the Wolof believers opportunities to share the love of Christ with their own people.
- Ask the Lord to raise up strong local churches among the Wolof.





Turk

Merhaba! My name is Silaah, and I belong to the Turk people in Turkey. I am a carpet-maker, meaning that I spin yarn, turn colorful knots into rugs, and embroider handmade carpets. Carpet-making has been a part of my family's tradition for many generations. I was taught by my mother, whose mother taught her, and so on. One tradition we have is using colors of the earth, such as dark green and brown, with bits of richer colors, such as royal purple and red. This piece of cloth I am holding is my latest creation! It can be made into many different things, like rugs or carpets, or perhaps a scarf of some sort. I can't wait to see what it becomes!



PRAYER ITEMS:

- Pray that churches and mission organizations will accept the challenge of reaching the Turks.
- Ask God to give Turkish believers and key leaders among the Turks boldness to share the gospel with their own people.
- Pray that Turkey will avoid both ethnic strife (especially with the Kurds) and resurgent Muslim fundamentalism.

- Ask the Lord to send additional long-term laborers to live among the Uzbeks and share the love of Christ with them.





Arab Northern Yemeni

(salam)! My name is Makin, and this is my wife, Rima. We both belong to the Northern Arab people group in Yemen. We recently got married a few months ago and have been living happily with each other since. The two of us are also the only Christians in our families. Both of us just came back from a secret gathering where we sang songs and gave praise to God. Because worshiping God is not allowed in Yemen, we have to be careful traveling to these gatherings. My hope is that one day Rima and I will be able to worship God freely with our families and community.




PRAYER ITEMS:
